

Consequences of Climate Change topic

"The Oscar-winning actor and environmentalist Leonardo DiCaprio has spent the past three years asking a wide variety of people around the world about climate change. His collection of interviews in the film – ranging from President Obama and the Pope through to Elon Musk and Piers Sellers– cover the science, impacts, vested interests, politics and possible solutions."

ACTIVITY:

You're going to watch the "Before de Flood" documentary.

Pre-task:

Read the questions before watching the documentary.

Task:

Watch the "Before de Flood" documentary, take some notes in your notebook and then answer the following questions. All the questions are in the order they appear in the video.

1. How are the humans caused mass extinctions in the past (Dodo, Passenger Pigeon, etc.) different than what is happening today?
2. How has the ice of the Baffin Islands changed during the hunters' lifetime?
3. In Florida what does the term "Sunny Day Flooding" mean?
4. Why do we ignore climate change? What does science have to say?

5. How is China addressing their environmental issues?
6. What does the ocean do for our climate / society? Why is it not doing this job?
7. Explain why and how forests store carbon. Why are the forests of Indonesia being destroyed?
8. Describe some of the key points that President Obama makes about Climate Change?

Post-task: LETTER WRITING ASSIGNMENT

Write a draft of a letter to Leonardo DiCaprio. Thank him for making this movie – this is going to be a very important part of history, and hopefully it will prompt a change. Tell him what you've learned from the movie. Tell him about your favorite (or the most impactful) one or two examples from the movie about climate change or what we need to do to stop climate change. Also, tell him what you plan to do to make changes based on what you learned from the movie.

Be sure to include the salutations (greeting and closing). You will be copying these letters onto awesome paper to send to him soon.
